Women in BIM Conference Sydney Snapshot

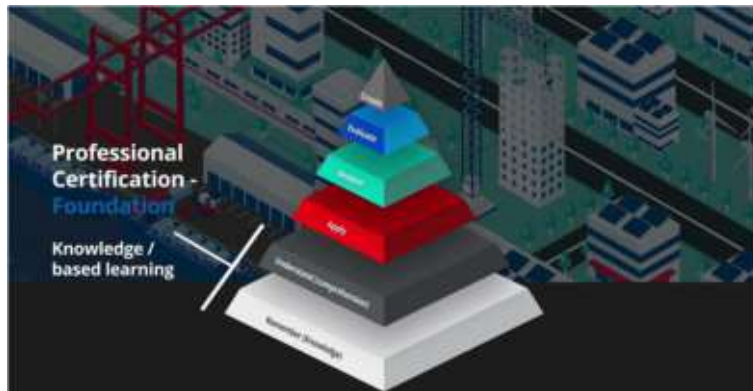
WiB Conference was a huge success with 180 attendees (women & men) supporting on the day.

Update: IFC 4.3 Working Group



IFC 4.3 (for Infrastructure) has been sent to the International Standards Organisation (ISO) for a final vote. All of the comments from the ISO review have been closed out. It is expected that the results of the voting should come back before the end of the year and there should be a finalised ISO standard for IFC4.3.



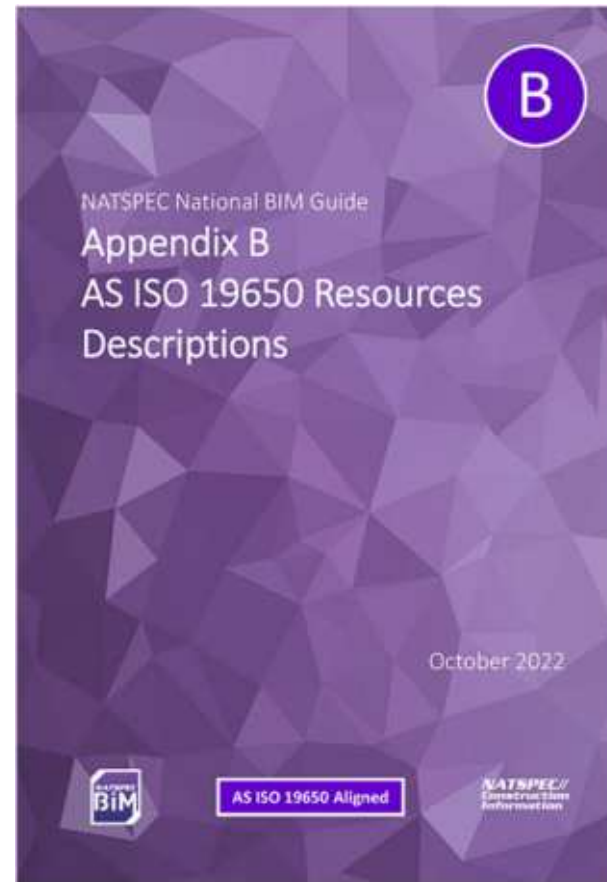
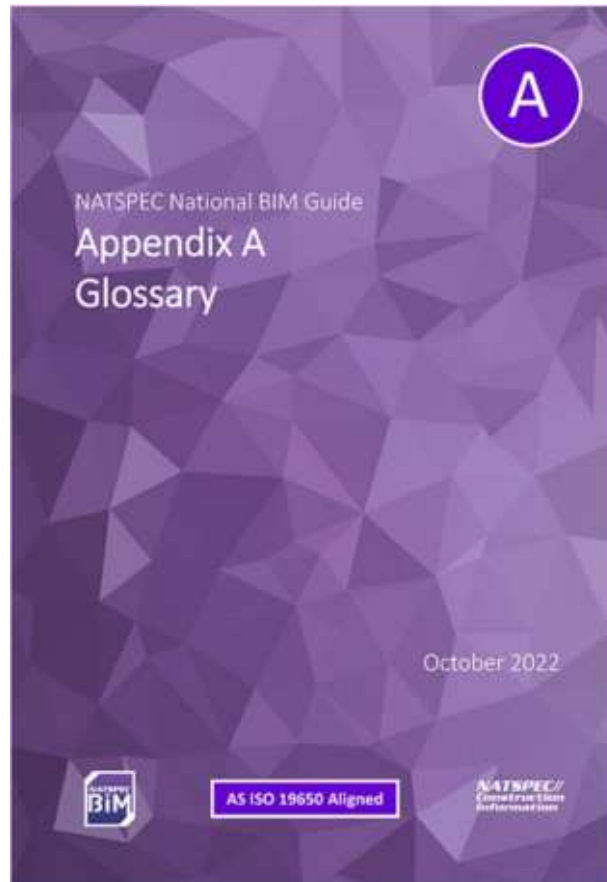
